Fashion Studies 20/30 is an intermediate and advanced course and is composed of 3 to 6 modules from CTS (Career and Technology Studies). For each successfully completed module (minimum of 50%), you will receive 1 credit. The required modules for Fashion 20 is:

- FAS2070: Creative Construction
- FAS2190: Textile Arts 2

The required modules for Fashion 30 is:

- FAS3060: Couture
- FAS3190: Textile Arts 3

Please note, you may only choose modules and receive credit of modules that you have not already received credit for. In the event that you have already received credit for the required module, a substitution will be made by the instructor.

The goal of CTS is to let students work at their own pace; this places a lot of responsibility on the student. The student must be disciplined enough to work to the best of their ability in class to get full credits in the course. Please be aware that this is a quarter class; therefore, this course will move at a quick pace. In order to keep up, exemplary attendance is a must.

Marking Criteria

Students should be aware that failure to complete an assignment could result in a loss of credits. Every module is marked on a different criteria.

Supplies

 - *Hand sewing needles*
 - *Seam gauge*
- Pattern, Fabric, and Notions.
- \$2.00 deposit for bobbin (this will be returned at the end of the course when the bobbin is returned)
