For this project you are expected to design a curling scoreboard. Your scoreboard must include 10 ends of play, a description of what has occurred in each end, the use of blank ends, and a final score. You will be expected to complete the following three-step process: 1. Plan your scoreboard and draw a rough draft; 2. Have your scoreboard proof read by a classmate and make sure there are no errors; and 3. Complete your finished product as a power point. You may also be asked to present your scoreboard to your class.

Take time to consider the following:

1. Your scoreboard must include two teams.
2. Make sure the score is placed between the two teams.
3. Use 10 ends of play.
4. Each end must have a score or be a blanked end.
5. The score is your choice.
6. Be sure to explain what happened each end (ie. Blue scores three points in the sixth end).
7. Only one team can score per end.
8. A team cannot score more than eight points per end (this is rarely accomplished).
9. The score is a running total.

The Finished Product

1. How are you going to organize your power point?
2. How many slides will you need to complete your power point? You should have at least one slide per end.
3. Does your scoreboard have a title?
4. Is your power point appealing to the eye? Is it neat? Have you used color?

Presentation???

Things to consider:

1. Can the person at the back of the room hear you and see what you are presenting?
2. Are you able to explain why you did what you did?
3. Do you need some special equipment (ie. projector)?
