
Course Selection for Grade 11 Planning for Success

What You Must Have to Graduate...

- ★ English at the 30 level (30-1 or 30-2)
- ★ Social Studies at the 30 level (30-1 or 30-2)
- ★ 10 credits in other 30-level courses (core courses or options)
- ★ Math to a grade 11 level
- ★ Science to a grade 11 level
- ★ PE 10
- **★** CALM
- ★ 10 credits in CTS, a second language, PE 20/30, or Fine Arts
- ★ 100 credits (105 credits at SHS for Recognition Ceremonies)


Course Progression




ESL English

- ★ Students can move from English 10-2 to ESL English 20-1 with a mark of 65%+.
- ★ At the grade 12 level, ESL students will need to choose English 30-2 and/or English 30-1. Next year, we will be offering ESL support for both these courses in Flextime.

CALM

- You must choose CALM as it is a requirement to graduate.
- Summer CALM is offered through Learning Academy
 - Students need to apply directly though GHLA website starting April 15th.
 - Students will not be registered in the course until they have paid the summer school fee

Gr. 10/11/12 Rutherford Requirements

- ★ English
- ★ At least two other cores (which may include a second language)
- ★ Two "clumped = sets of 3" CTS courses, or other courses worth either 3 or 5 credits (for grade 12 calculation, both must be 5 credits)
- \star 75-79% = \$300(10)/\$500(11)/\$700(12)
- \star 80% > = \$400(10)/\$800(11)/\$1300(12)
- ★ Both English and Social 30-1 and 30-2 can be used for Rutherford Scholarship

Course Selection cont'd

- ★ Students should not select more or fewer classes than will fill 8 – five credit blocks of time. (choose 3 credit classes in pairs to fill a block).
- ★ You may go on to the next level in the course if you were successful in the previous or prerequisite course.

Success is defined as a minimum of 50%; however, most students will struggle at the next level with a mark below 60% and should consider dropping a level.

- **Exception 1:** Math 20-1. You need 65%+ in Math 10C to progress directly to Math 20-1; otherwise, you must complete Math 20-2 first.
- **Exception 2:** Physics 20. you need 65%+ in BOTH Math 10C and Science 10 to progress to Physics 20.

Course Selection cont'd

- ★ If you failed an academic course (English or Social 10-1, Math 10C, or Science 10) with 40-49%you can either,
 - Move to the lower level grade 11/12 course (English or Social 20-2, Math 20-3, or Science 24) and receive RETROACTIVE credits once you have successfully passed the course or
 - Re-do the course
- o If you failed the course with marks below 39% you must retake the course or move to the lower level at the same grade level (eg. Eng 10-1 to Eng 10-2)

Course Selection cont'd

- Teacher choice is not available.
- This year, we are moving to **PICK & STICK** for option classes. In completing course selections, students are booking a spot in specific classes.
- We DO NOT offer a hybrid program with Learning Academy.
- If you wish to take a course online that we offer at SHS, you will be expected to carry a full schedule here.
- Storefront School is NOT a school of choice. Admission is based on need and availability and is determined at the district level.

Some final thoughts...

- ★ More and more colleges and universities are making initial decisions about accepting you based on your GRADE 11 marks
- ★ Marks in CTS courses can be calculated/used for the Rutherford Scholarship and for admission to some post-secondary programs within Alberta, but very few outside Alberta.
- ★ It's OK if you don't know "what you want to be when you grow up" plan to have five 30-level course to apply to university.
 - English
 - Math
 - 2 other academics (sciences, social studies, or languages)
 - a fifth subject (drama, dance, art, etc.)
- ★ Please don't look for the EASY WAY out. Employers and post-secondary institutions are looking for the best you can be!
- ★ If you are planning to only take Science and/or math to a grade 11 level, you need to ensure that you are taking at least 2 option classes at the 20 and 30 levels by the end of next year.
